

Green Lake Fields – Set-up Routine

1. Net Installation Duties


All nets are stored in the tan WSC locker at the SW baseball diamond. This is near Soccer Field #4. The bin is locked with a keyed lock. The bin will be unlocked Friday afternoons for lining and will stay open through the weekend.

The lid tends to stick. PULL HARD UPWARDS to open the lid.

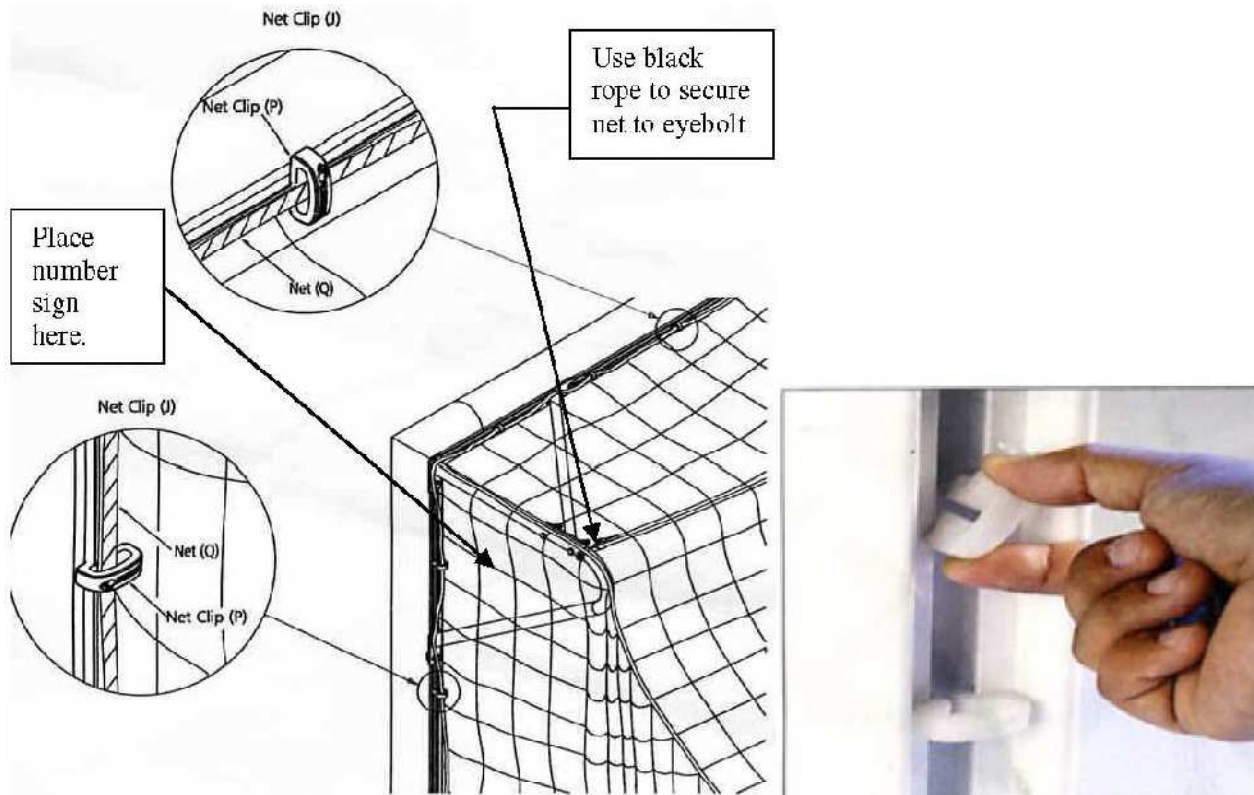
There are two sizes of nets used on the goals:

Fields 1 - 4: 6.5' x **12'** Part Number: 3B5821

Fields 5 - 6: 6.5' x **18'** Part Number: 3B5721

- Select the correct net size for the goal – see sizes above.
- In general, the 6.5 x 18 nets are on the right side of the locker; the 6.5 x 12 nets are on the left side.
- Take the nets to the fields.
- Unfold the net.
- Locate the black nylon rope. Remove it from the net. This will be used to hold the net out of the goal mouth. Secure the rope between the round eyebolts on the top corner braces. Use the carabiners to secure the rope.
- Unfold the net to locate the two top, front corners of the net. These are marked with a white or black tag.
- Grab the net and pull it over and around the goal.
- Use the white plastic Kwik Goal net clips (look like this: ) to secure the net in place. There are three plastic bins that hold the clips. Do not drop or lose these net clips!
- Place the net clips around the perimeter rope and secure into the channel on the metal frame. Place the net clips in parallel to the channel and then TWIST 90 degrees. Use every 1.5 feet (about every four squares in the net) to secure each net to the goal.

- Hang number plates on the top side of net once installed. Facing the net from the field, this would be the top right inside corner. The number plates are held in place with pear shaped shower curtain rings.



2. Goal Anchoring Duties

CHECK THE ANCHORS! The goals should already be held in place with 4 stakes. Ensure the stakes are in place and secure. Safety is important!

3. Cleanup

- Make sure all the unused supplies (liners, plastic clip bin, paint) are returned the appropriate bin. **DO NOT** place the plastic clip bins on the top shelf of the locker. If they are on the top shelf they will get crushed when the lid is closed.
- Close the storage bin. But, **DO NOT LOCK** the storage bin. Thanks!
