

WALLINGFORD FIELD INSTRUCTIONS

Wallingford Park is located at [Wallingford Avenue North & N 42nd St.](#)

The field is lined to hold 5 small-sized fields. Field 1 is the East field. Field 2 is next in. Field 3 is SW, Field 4 is W, and Field 5 is NW. Here is the [Wallingford park layout](#).

Each week there are two teams that handle the field equipment. One team sets up before the first game at 9am. The other team takes the equipment home and sets up the fields the following week.

TAKE DOWN

Take down all equipment for all fields. Take the equipment home and keep it until the next week.

Field Equipment:

The equipment you should
have for 5 fields:

20 large traffic cones
20 pieces of PVC pipe

MAINTENANCE

City Parks mows the grass on occasion. Woodland Soccer lines (“stripes”) the fields before each weekend. The striping is the responsibility of the WSC Wallingford Field Striper.

SET UP * NEW AND IMPROVED *****

You simply need to set up the goals. Each "goal" consists of 2 "goal posts" (traffic cones with PVC pipe in them). Fields 1 & 2 use 6 foot goals. Fields 3-5 use 8 foot goals. These should be lined on the fields.
